

# Auca (Waoarani) Mission Time Line

1940-----THE \*AUCAS, SCATTERED THROUGHOUT THE SOUTHEASTERN JUNGLES OF ECUADOR, SPEAR ANY OUTSIDERS WHO ENTER THEIR TERRITORY, SPEARING EVEN THEIR OWN FAMILY AND CLAN MEMBERS. DAYUMA'S FAMILY GROUP NUMBERS ABOUT 200. SHE FLEES THE VILLAGE TO SAVE HER OWN LIFE.

1956-----FIVE MISSIONARIES SPEARED ON PALM BEACH. RACHEL SAINT, SISTER OF PILOT, NATE SAINT, LEADS DAYUMA TO FAITH IN CHRIST OUTSIDE THE VILLAGE

1957-----DAYUMA RETURNS TO AUCA VILLAGE, FINDS HER FAMILY GROUP REDUCED TO ONLY 40, DUE TO INTERNAL WARFARE. DAYUMA SECURES PERMISSION FOR RACHEL SAINT AND ELIZABETH ELLIOT TO LIVE IN TIWAENO VILLAGE.

1958-----RACHEL AND ELIZABETH, WITH DAUGHTER VALERIE, WALK FOR TWO DAYS TO TIWAENO VILLAGE

1960-----FORREY DROPS WHEEL-BARROW AND TOOLS TO BUILD AIRSTRIP. FIVE AUCA KILLERS BECOME BELIEVERS

1960-----FORREY FLYS ED McCULLY'S FATHER AND PHIL SAINT, RACHEL AND NATE'S BROTHER, TO VISIT AUCAS

1961-----PRESIDENT OF ECUADOR VISITS WITH AUCAS, HEARS KIMO'S TESTIMONY, COMMENDS OUR WORK

1961-----FIRST ELEVEN AUCA BELIEVERS BAPTIZED. CATHIE PEEKE JOINS RACHEL TO WORK ON AUCA LINGUISTICS

1962-----MARGARET AND BABY ANITA FLY WITH FORREY TO VISIT AUCAS

1966-----PAT KELLY JOINS TEAM TO DO LITERACY WORK

1968-----BELIEVERS MAKE FRIENDLY CONTACT WITH SAVAGE DOWNRIVER AUCAS; POLIO EPIDEMIC CRIPPLES SAVAGES; BELIEVERS MOVE THEM TO TIWAENO, CARRYING THE SICKEST ON STRETCHERS

1972-----ROSI JUNG, TRANSLATOR FROM WYCLIFFE-GERMANY, JOINS THE TRANSLATION TEAM

1973-----JIM AND KATHY YOST ARRIVE TO DO ANTHROPOLOGICAL STUDIES. VIDEO LATER AIRED ON PUBLIC TELEVISION

1992-----AUCA NEW TESTAMENT DEDICATED, MORE BELIEVERS BAPTIZED. WYCLIFFE COMPLETES WORK IN ECUADOR

1998-----FORREY REUNITED AT WHEATON ACADEMY WITH MINKAYE AND TEMENTA AFTER 35 YEARS

2003-----STEVE SAINT DEDICATING THIS YEAR TO MAKING A FULL-LENGTH MOVIE OF THE HISTORY, MARTYRDOM, AND SUBSEQUENT EVENTS REGARDING THE AUCA (WAODANI) PEOPLE OF ECUADOR

2006-----"END OF THE SPEAR" MOVIE SHOWN IN THEATRES ACROSS THE USA. "END OF THE SPEAR" BOOK PUBLISHED BY TYNDALE.
